Dear Mr. Duceppe:

More than 400 dead and more than 2000 injured, and with 100 tons of bombs dropped in the first nine hours on a civilian population that is no match for such massive aerial bombardment. This is an extremely disproportionate response to any perceived threat to Israel. Such massive bombardment cannot be seen as anything but an attack on the entire civilian population of Gaza. It should be considered a war crime.

The Canadian government must take immediate action to put pressure on Israel to stop the massacre and lift the siege. Canada must provide immediate humanitarian relief to the people of Gaza. We call on the government of Canada to match donations raised by Canadian registered charities for the people of Gaza.

I hereby call upon you to press our government to act immediately to stop the massacre, lift the siege, and provide aid to the victims of Israeli aggression.
